

Amalie Labradoodles – Puppy Export



We would like an Amalie puppy and live outside Australia – what do we do?

Please complete a “**Wishlist**” application online via the Amalie website asking us to invoice you – there is no need to pay the application fee at this stage. We will usually be able to give you an indication when a puppy that meets your needs might be available.



What costs are involved?

Other than the cost of the puppy (Ex GST), additional costs will be required for boarding, health care, export permits and clearances, travel and import to the country of destination. On arrival there may be additional fees associated with clearance of the puppy from the national authorities. As each country is different and fees are subject to change, please contact us for an indicative quotation. This may need to be revised closer to the puppy’s travel date.

You will be responsible for investigating what costs and logistics are involved in the country you will be importing the puppy to. You may also need to arrange relevant documentation or permits and you will need to make arrangement for payment of any in-country fees. These will be in addition to any quotation provided by Amalie Labradoodles.



What costs are covered by the quotation from Amalie?

All Amalie companion puppies are desexed, microchipped, age appropriately vaccinated, wormed and checked by our vet. We offer a 3 year health guarantee and our commitment to ongoing support and advice as needed. We will coordinate all export procedures in Australia. What costs are NOT covered by the quotation from Amalie?

Our quotation does not cover insurance, transportation from the destination airport to your home or any in-country fees on arrival. Customs clearance, quarantine inspection and airport terminal fees cannot be pre-paid and need to be arranged in-country by you, as the buyer.



What else do I need to know?

For your pup’s travel, we aim to get the best service at competitive rates. We consider transit times and our preferred carrier is Departure Pets. Please also refer to relevant government websites for the importing country.

Your puppy pack will come with your pup and will include vaccination record, a collar, lead. We are able to wean your pup on to a premium dog food available in the country of import so let us know what your plans are or what’s available by 6 weeks of age or so.
